REGULAR SESSION

The Governing Body met in Regular Session in the City Council Chambers. Mayor Joe Andrasek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following present: Councilmembers Andrew Erb, Dana Dawson, Jolene Biggs, Chad Somers, Cory Urban, and Brock McPherson. Absent were councilmembers Jessica Milsap and Dan Heath. Also in attendance were City Administrator Kendal Francis, City Attorney Robert Suelter and City Clerk Shawna Schafer.

A. CONSENT AGENDA

- a) **Minutes:** Minutes of the Regular Session held on February 4, 2019.
- b) **Claim's Warrant Register #2-19-19:** Covering 2019 bills to date in the amount of \$412,350.06.
- c) **Payroll Register P/R 2-15-19:** Covering payroll ending February 9, 2019 in the amount of \$415,442.44.
- d) **Appointments:** Mayor Andrasek made no appointments.
- e) **Speed Limit on Eighth Street:** Eighth Street is now open and speed limit from Grant to McKinley needs to be posted. It is recommended that it be posted at 30 miles per hour for vehicle traveling in both directions. Approval of Resolution Number 021919-A to post speed limit at 30 miles per hour.
- f) **Agenda:** Approval of agenda as submitted or amended.

Mr. Urban made a motion to approve the consent agenda. The motion was seconded by Mr. Erb and passed with all voting in favor.

B. OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business.

C. RECOGNITION OF VISITORS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS: There were no visitors or announcements.

D. NEW BUSINESS

1. **Councilmember Reports:** There were no councilmember reports.
2. **Administrators Update:** City Administrator Kendal Francis distributed his report regarding activities of various city departments.

3. **CVB/Community Coordinator Report:** Community Coordinator Christina Hayes presented her monthly report

4. **Job Fest Sponsor:** Scott Donovan appeared before the Governing Body to discuss the 2019 Job Fest to be held at the Great Bend Events Center on April 25, 2019. After discussion, Mr. Urban made a motion to be a \$1,000 sponsor of the April 25, 2019 Job Fest Event. The motion was seconded by Mr. Somers and passed by a vote of 5 to 1 with Mr. McPherson voting no.

5. **Amend Cereal Malt Beverage (CMB) Regulations:** City Attorney Robert Suelter reported that the State of Kansas has amended its statutes allowing enhanced beer with alcohol content up to 6% to be sold in businesses holding cereal malt beverage licenses effective April 1, 2019. Currently, Cereal Malt Beverage has been defined in Kansas as containing not more than 3.2% alcohol. Breweries are no longer going to produce this type of alcohol. The City's CMB Ordinance needs to be amended to come into line with the state statute allowing enhanced beer with alcohol content up to 6% to be sold in businesses holding a CMB License. Ms. Biggs made a motion to approve Ordinance Number 4330. This motion was seconded by Mr. Dawson and passed with all voting in favor.

ADJOURNMENT: Mr. Urban made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Erb seconded this motion and passed with all voting in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 7:17 pm.
